Friday, April 16, 2021. All applications, including transcripts must be received by 5:00 p.m. on April 16. Late applications will not be considered.

Who can enter?

Student must be a U.S. citizen, a Bridgeland High School senior graduating May 2021 and planning to attend a two-or four-year accredited college or university. Scholarships will be awarded based on financial need to students in good standing with Bridgeland High School.

Why should I enter?

Entry process:
